1. Cut out the mask template and glue it to cardboard. Cut around the cardboard.



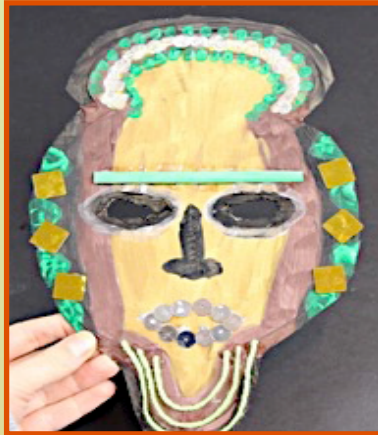
2. Ask a teacher for help to cut out the eyes. It can be difficult.

6. For an extra challenge, find some materials to make a head piece.

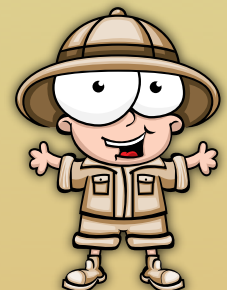


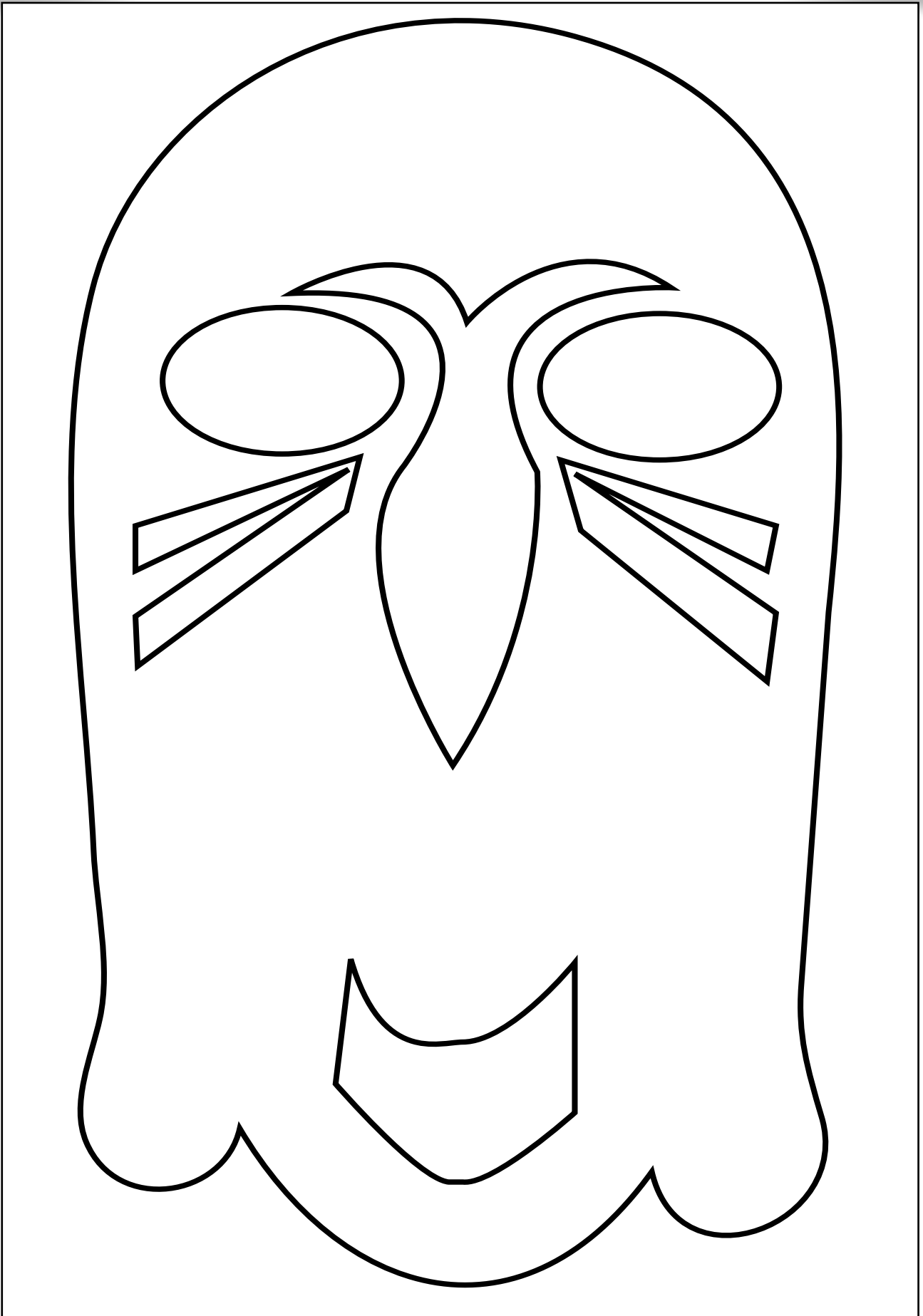
7. Lolly sticks, feathers, straws, pipe cleaners and beads are great options.

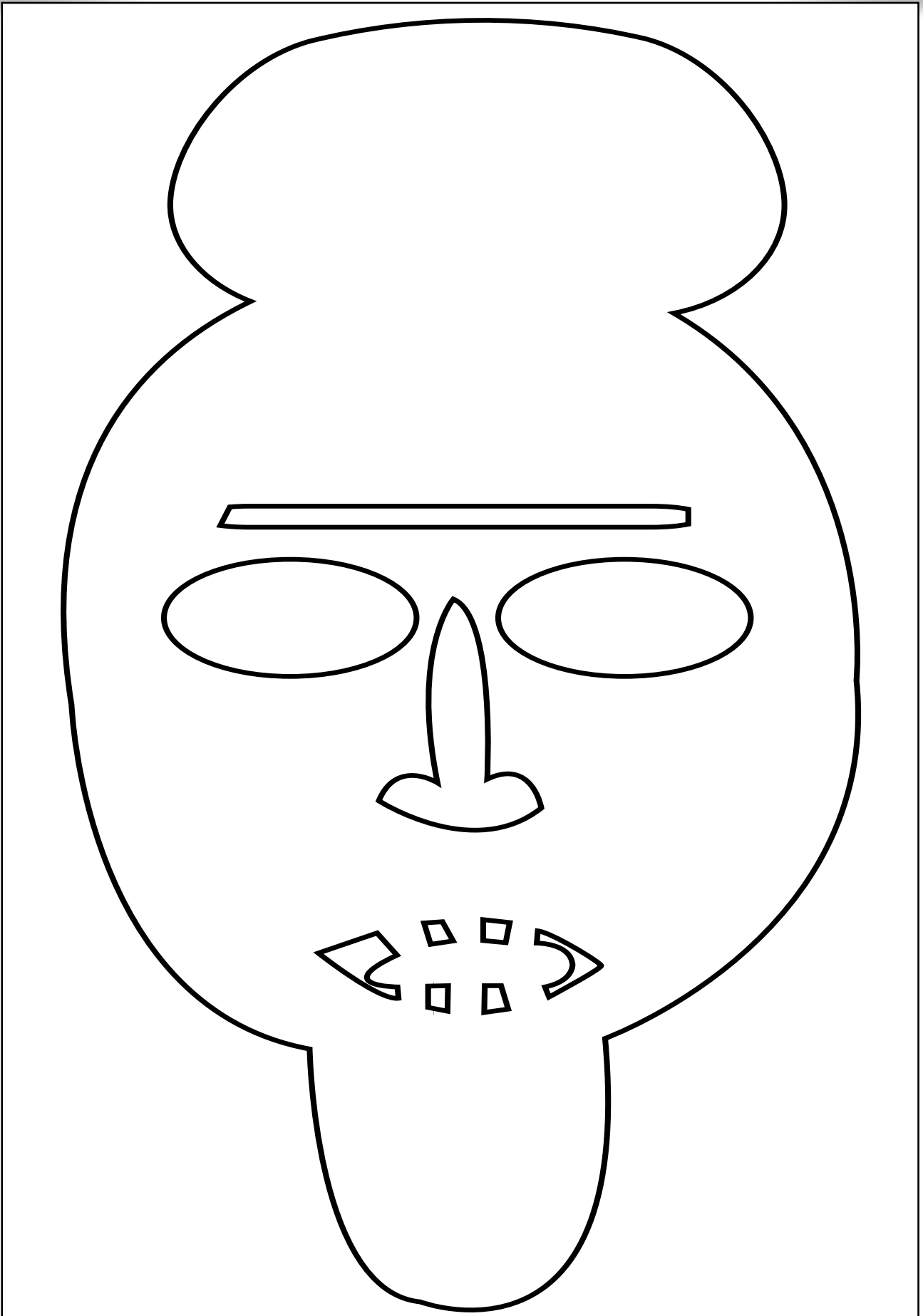


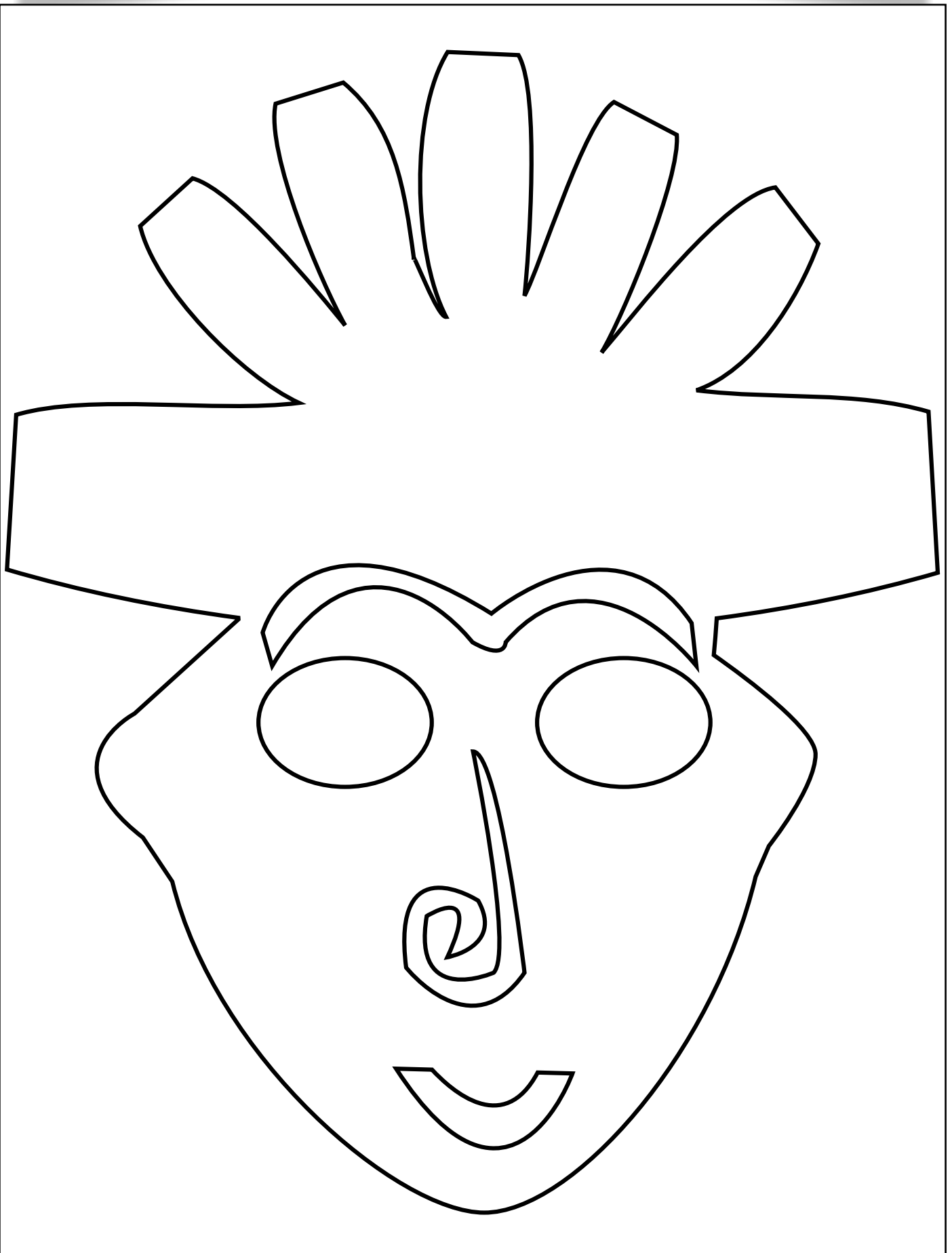
8. When you have made your head pieces attach them to the mask with tape.

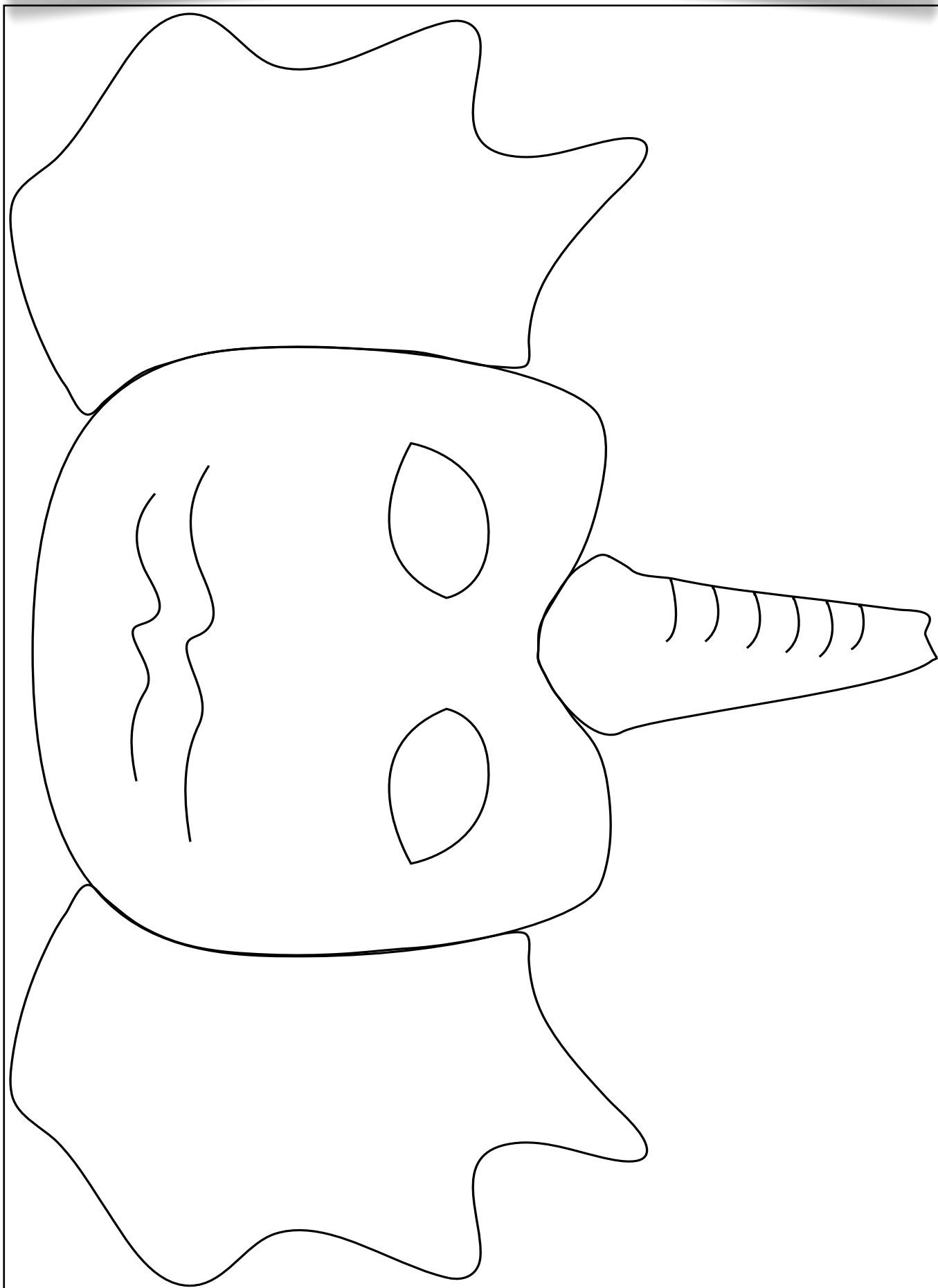
