

The school has a policy of encouraging the wearing of school uniform in order to foster pride in the school and to aid the development of a school identity. This is apart from the practical benefits for parents and children.

The uniform has been chosen to be as simple and as readily available as possible.

Royal blue sweatshirt with logo, available to order from school or other royal blue jumper or cardigan

White or pale blue shirt, polo shirt or blouse

Black or navy trousers, skirt or pinafore.

In summer blue gingham dresses may be worn.

#### **For P.E.**

White tee shirt with logo, available to order from school or other white tee shirt

Blue shorts available to order from school or other blue shorts

P.E. kit bag available to order from school, or other kit bag

Gym shoes or trainers for outdoor P.E. lessons - separate from normal school shoes.

#### **Parents are asked:**

- **not** to buy ties for the children to wear as they can be a safety hazard
- to ensure that school shoes are safe and fit for their purpose. High heels or large thick soles can be hazardous in a school with flights of stairs.
- to write the child's name on every outer garment worn to school (not socks or underwear)
- Make-up, jewellery are not appropriate for school
- One stud can be worn in each ear, no hoops or hanging earrings permitted
- Hair style and colouring should be suitable for school (natural colours only)
